All you need to train peer mediators for your own HIV prevention project with migrant and mobile populations or ethnic minorities.

AIDS&Mobility involves migrants in delivering HIV prevention information to their own communities. After participating in training and receiving their transcultural mediator's certificate, these peer educators initiate, organise and conduct information sessions in their own languages, making their communities aware of HIV prevention and related topics.

This Master Toolkit contains all the materials you need to implement a similar transcultural HIV and AIDS mediator project or just explore the model.

Its comprehensive "How to Use the A&M Master Toolkit" guide gives you relevant background information, explains the transcultural mediator model, suggests a handy checklist to assess how well you are prepared for this kind of work and provides step-by-step instructions to build your own project.
